Whether you have goals based around building confidence or new skills, increased independence or meeting new people, our organised holidays can support you to reach these goals.

From short breaks to big adventures, we endeavour to go above and beyond to make it happen, because we believe anything is possible.

Our small group adventures are designed to cultivate a community of mutual support and friendship. You will get to become a part of this community and discover exciting new places with people who share similar interests.

We also create tailored one on one accessible itineraries, making travel barrier free for the people we support.

Funding your support

Beyond Borders Travel has been established for many years and is part of UnitingCare, a registered provider under the NDIS. That means we provide a range of services and supports under the NDIS.

Any of the support you require to go on a holiday can typically be funded by the NDIS out of your core support budget under daily activities and social and community participation. The cost of support varies depending on the destination, the duration of the trip and the support needs of each individual.

The standard support ratio on our supported small group adventures is 1:3, however we recommend

one on one (1:1) support for people traveling with us for the first time. This gives you the opportunity to go at your own pace while you get to know us and allows us to develop a plan to best support you on your future adventures.

The out-of-pocket expenses are the costs that would be incurred by anyone going on holiday, such as transportation (like car travel, flights or rail), meals, accommodation and sightseeing.

Accommodation has been assessed to meet COVID-19 standards. UnitingCare sees the health and wellbeing of all participants as paramount and as such COVID-19 safe plans will apply for all holiday adventures.



Food

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are all included in our pricing, and we offer a wide variety of choice that caters to all dietary and nutritional needs.

We encourage healthy choices and like to get everyone involved in the process of choosing where to eat or preparing the meals ourselves. We keep our groups small so that we can be spontaneous and support local businesses wherever we can.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions there will be not buffet style or sharing of meals.



Transport



Our prices include all transportation costs. All holidays depart from Brisbane but if you live elsewhere in Australia we can customise a quote for you.

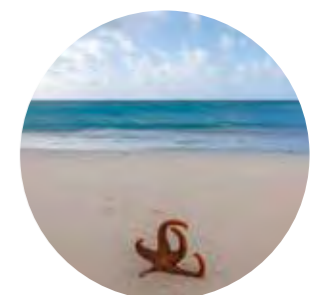

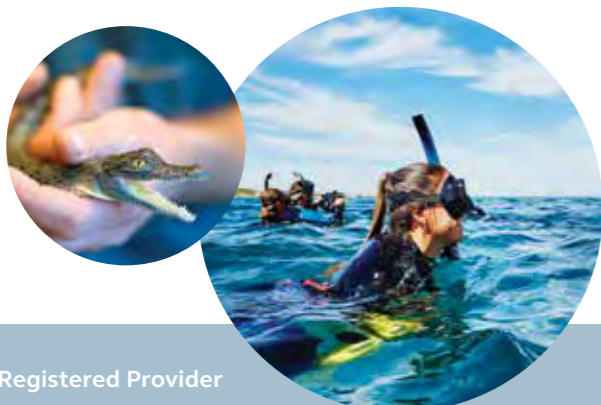

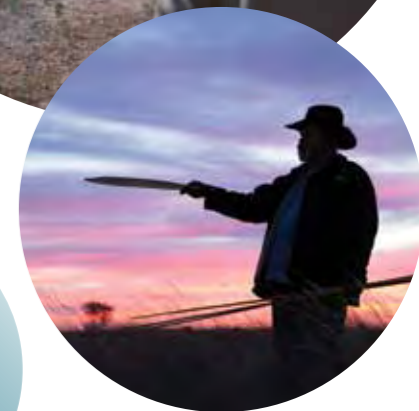
AYERS ROCK TO ALICE SPRINGS 18 – 23 AUGUST

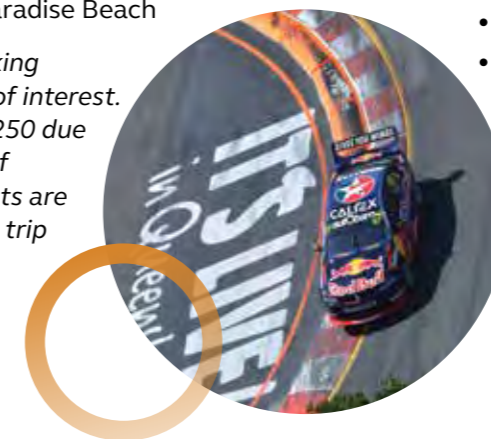

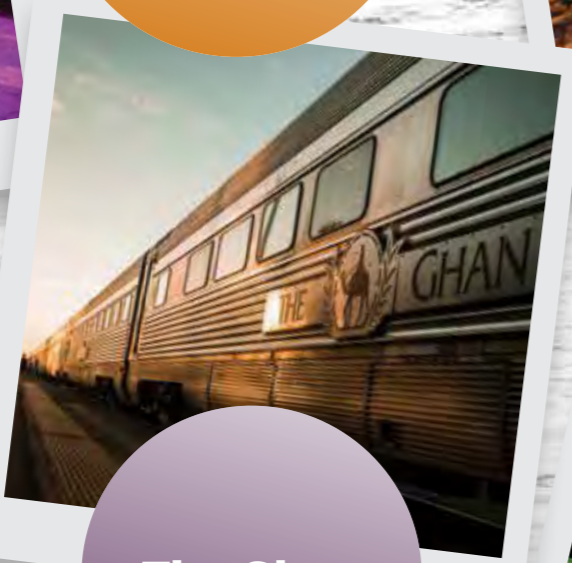

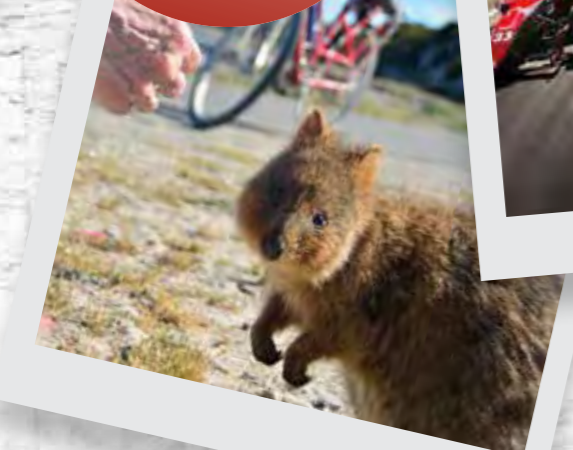

Travelling beyond COVID-19

Just because we are socially distancing doesn't mean we have to feel socially isolated.

The COVID-19 pandemic has changed all of our lives. As much as we would love to get out there and start travelling all over the globe, we have to be cautious to ensure the safety of our travellers and our support teams. We understand that you might want to make up for lost time so we assure you we adhere to the Government Guidelines around social distancing on our supported holidays.

In 2021 we have a strong focus on local short stays, with some more exotic destinations included. All holidays featured in this brochure are subject to availability and change; we will do our best to provide holidays on the dates listed but there may be cases where we have to move or postpone holidays. If the purpose of the holiday is to attend a festival or special event it will be subject to any restrictions around social gatherings based on the dates of the event.

Please let us know if you or anyone you have come into contact with has tested positive for COVID-19. Prior to your holiday, if you are feeling unwell you are required to advise us so that we can ensure all of our travellers and support staff are not put at unnecessary risk. Keep yourself safe and help us to prevent the spread of illness in the communities we visit.

Pictures in this brochure that show travellers standing less than 1.5 metres apart were taken prior to COVID-19.

Supported small group adventures

1. I have always wanted to travel, is Beyond Borders Travel going to be able to make that happen?

Yes. We offer a range of local short-stays for people who are travelling with us for the first time.

2. How do I get started?

Contact us for details. We recommend one on one support for your first holiday.

3. What ratio of support can I expect from Beyond Borders Travel?

Prices listed are based on a group support ratio of 1:3 but 1:1 support is also available upon request.

4. Will I meet other people on my trip?

Yes, our supported small group adventures provide an opportunity for people to make new friends.

5. Can I choose to bring my own support?

Yes, you can bring either a support worker, and friend or family member. Give us a call to enquire about how we can do this.

6. What if I want to go somewhere that you don't offer in your small group adventures?

We can create a customised one on one itinerary for you so you can experience the world beyond your borders.

7. Can I come on a holiday if I have complex needs?

Yes, we have people in our team that specialise in supporting people with a broad range of complex needs and we offer 1:1 support.

8. Will I have someone to help me with my personal care requirements?

Yes. We allocate rooms based on peoples personal care needs. If you have high personal care needs we can also offer 1:1 support.

9. Do I have to live in Brisbane?

No, we have travellers who join our holidays from all over Australia. Contact us for a custom quote from where you live.

10. Do I have to have a disability to go on a holiday with Beyond Borders?

No, there are no eligibility criteria. We have travellers who work and live independently, as well as people who are in aged care.

11. Can I bring my assistance dog on my holiday?

Yes. It may depend on the destination but we can make this work for you.

12. Will you be able to cater to my dietary requirements?

Yes, we cater to all dietary requirements and food allergies. Healthy options are always encouraged and sugary drinks are avoided.

13. Will you help with administering medication and help me prevent any allergic reactions?

Yes, our support team are trained in administering Epipens, insulin and a varied range of medications as well as peg feeding.

Where prices are not listed in the brochure call us to find out more details. Holidays fill up fast so we encourage you to let us know if there are any of interest to you so we can ensure you don't miss out.

Bespoke program – the answer is always YES

1. Can I choose to bring my own support?

YES, we can customise a holiday where you bring your own support. We can also provide the support for you as its your holiday, your way.

2. Can you provide a support worker that can drive me around on my holiday?

Yes, our support team can bring one of the vans from our fleet if you're planning to travel locally to the South East Queensland region.

3. Can you help me develop an itinerary that is accessible and suits my needs?

Yes, once we have an understanding of your needs we can design an itinerary to match you, it's your holiday, your way.

4. Can you meet me at Brisbane airport if I want to visit this area?

Yes, we can meet you and drive you to where you need to go. We can help with booking accommodation, sightseeing anything else you want to experience.

5. Can you support me if I need to travel for personal reasons?

Yes, whatever reason you are travelling, our highly skilled team can support you.

6. Can you support me if I want to take a holiday somewhere with my family or friends?

Yes, if you are travelling with your family we can support you in the destination. You don't have to miss out on those important moments with the people closest to you, whether you are attending a wedding or graduation we can be there for you.

Can you provide me with a support worker that has experience in supporting people with my unique requirements?

Yes, our team have experience supporting people with a broad range of needs so once we understand your individual needs we can develop a support plan tailored to suit you.

7. What is the NDIS?

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is the new system through which people with disability can access support and government funding. It is designed to provide you with greater choice and control over the supports you receive and who provides them.

Nate's goal is to achieve increased independence so, as a stand-up comedian himself, he went on a Comedy Cruise. As his first holiday with Beyond Borders Nate decided to bring Alex from his team to support him one on one and give him the freedom to go at his own pace.

After returning from the cruise Nate said he would be comfortable leaving Alex at home next time and utilising our group support which shows he has more confidence about travelling as a result of his first holiday being a success.
